Joy of Mathematics

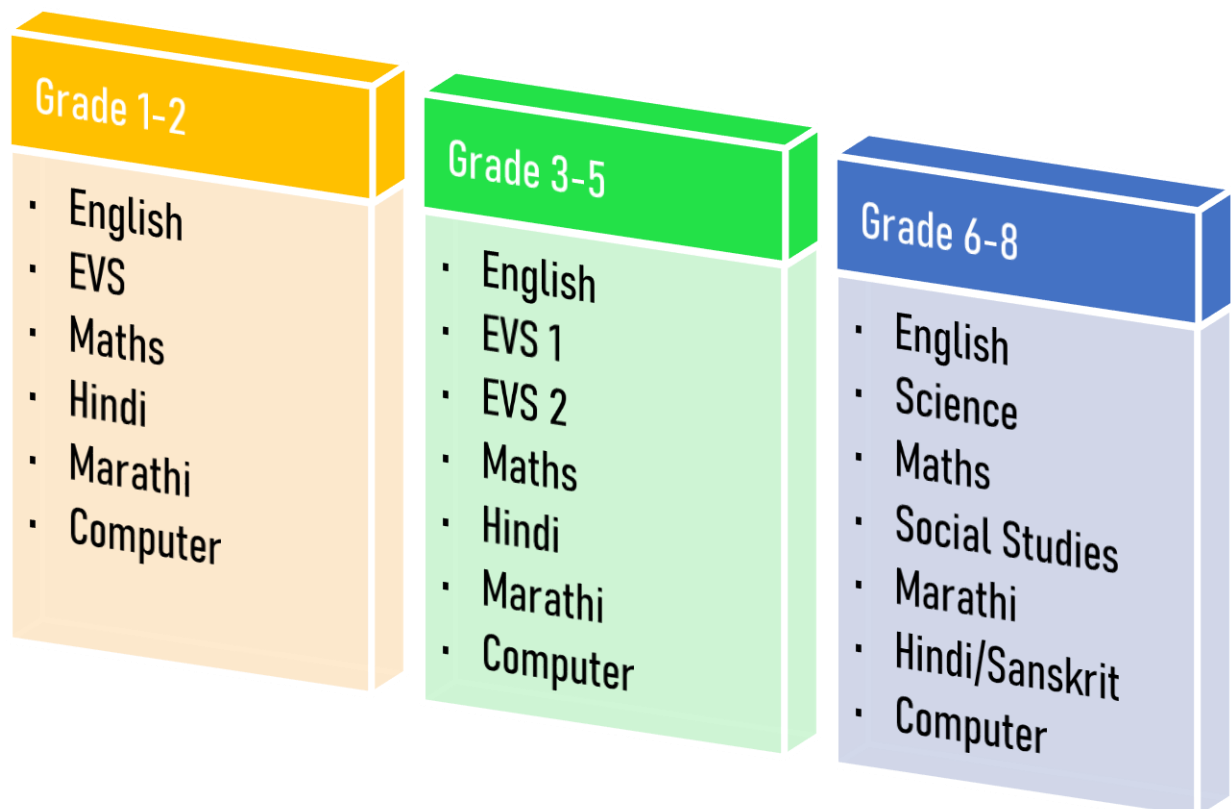
Mathematics is taught through learning by doing. Children are made to love and enjoy the subject in a creative way by providing them a wide range of mathematical activities.
